- Replace outdated computers throughout the year to ensure students and staff have access to technology.
- Assist in funding 1.0 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) teacher.
- Continue with the reward system for attendance and behaviour of 95%-100%.
- Purchase TrackED to update our reporting system to accommodate new Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) introduction in 2019.

Our initiatives include

- Increasing bandwidth infrastructure to ensure accessibility in technology for students and staff.
- Engaging in quality professional development aligned with Annual Implementation Plan priority (Reading).
- A reward system to acknowledge students' attendance rate and behaviour 95% - 100% each term.
- Implementation of new and improved Student Data Tracking from Years 7-10.
